**SOUTH AFRICA & NAMIBIA 5-27 DECEMBER 1999**

5 <sup>th</sup>	Arrive Johannesburg, drive to Phalaborwa via Pietersburg. Later afternoon & night drive Croc Ranch
6 <sup>th</sup>	Early morning game drive Croc Ranch, drive to Kruger mid-morning, afternoon Phalaborwa Gate to Olifants. Afternoon game drive SW of Olifants.
7 <sup>th</sup>	Dawn game drive S to Gudzani, returned to Olifants & then N to Shingwedzi via Letaba, late afternoon SE of Shingwedzi.
8 <sup>th</sup>	Am. Shingwedzi – Punda Maria via Mphongolo Loop. Afternoon Mahonie Loop followed by night drive.
9 <sup>th</sup>	Am. Pafuri area, pm Mahonie Loop.
10 <sup>th</sup>	Am. Pafuri area followed by drive to Shingwedzi. Pm. Drive to Letaba, late afternoon drive W of Letaba
11 <sup>th</sup>	Am. Letaba to Satara via Gudzani, Timbavati, Girivana, Rockvale & Nsemani. Pm. Girivana & Nsemani followed by Satara night drive.
12 <sup>th</sup>	Am. Girivana, Nsemani & Gudzani loop. Pm. Satara to Gudzani east.
13 <sup>th</sup>	Am. Satara to Skukuza to Lower Sable (via Renosterkoppies) to Skukuza. Pm. Areas S of Skukuza including Vervoer and Renosterkoppies.
14 <sup>th</sup>	Am. Skukuza – Pretoriuskop (via Renosterkoppies) – Skukuza. Pm. Areas S of Skukuza
15 <sup>th</sup>	Am. Skukuza to Numbi Gate via Renosterkoppies and Pretoriuskop. Pm. Return to Johannesburg for afternoon flight to Windhoek, night near Windhoek.
16 <sup>th</sup>	Am. Daan Viljeon followed by drive to Swakopmund. Pm. Trekoppies. Night Swakopmund.
17 <sup>th</sup>	Am. Walvis Bay & Rooiport. Pm. Cape Cross including night drive. Night Henties Bay.
18 <sup>th</sup>	Am. Cape Cross & Spitzkope. Pm. Cape Cross night drive, night Henties Bay.
19 <sup>th</sup>	Am. Long drive to Etosha via Uis, Omaruru & Outjo arriving mid-afternoon. Pm. Game drive near Okaukuejo. Night Okaukuejo.
20 <sup>th</sup>	Am. Okaukuejo area followed by drive to Halali. Pm. Rhino Drive near Halali, night Halali.
21 <sup>st</sup>	Am. Halali area, drive to Namutoni. Pm. Andoni Plain, night Namutoni.
22 <sup>nd</sup>	Am. Fischer's Pan & Namutoni area. Pm. Andoni Plain, night Namutoni.
23 <sup>rd</sup>	Am. Bloubokdraai & Klein Namutoni followed by drive to Halali via Eland Drive. Pm. Goas waterhole & Eland Drive, night Halali.
24 <sup>th</sup>	Am. Halali to Okaukuejo via Goas & Nuamses. Pm. Olifantsbad & Aus. Night Okaukuejo.
25 <sup>th</sup>	Am. Gemsbokvlakte. Pm. Long drive to Hobatere followed by night drive. Night Hobatere.
26 <sup>th</sup>	All day Hobatere including night drive producing Aardvark.
27 <sup>th</sup>	Long drive Hobatere to Windhoek for afternoon flight to London.

<b>Cape Fox</b>	-	Three Etosha (Nuamses) see Honey Badger
<b>Bat-eared Fox</b>	-	Etosha, two pairs with 3 & 2 young near Gamsbokvlakte, pair with three young near Halali, and three near Ondonjab. Two Hobatere watched feeding at night by placing ears to the ground to listen for insects.
<b>Black-backed Jackal</b>	Four Croc Ranch Kruger, a total of 10 seen on 6 days	6+ Cape Cross Two Henties Bay Etosha, seen on 6 out of 7 days, a total of 24 including one small pup and a family group of five 12+ Hobatere
<b>Honey Badger</b>	-	One Etosha (Nuamses) attempted to dig at Cape Fox den and chased off by the foxes
<b>Banded Mongoose</b>	c.10 Mphongolo Trail, Kruger	-
<b>Slender Mongoose</b>	Singles Mphongolo Trail & near Pafuri, Kruger	One Etosha, near Namutoni, successfully raided the nest of Kalahari Robins despite being mobbed by the adult robins and a Crimson-breasted Boubou
<b>Dwarf Mongoose</b>	All Kruger c.15 Mphongolo Trail Two Mahonie Loop. Punda Maria One N'watimhiri Road, Skukuza	-

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<b>Yellow Mongoose</b>	-	Four singles Etosha all in Halali area One between Etosha & Outjo
<b>Mongoose sp</b>	Four Croc Ranch (probably Dwarf) Three Shingwedzi, Kruger (probably Dwarf) Three singles Mphongolo Trail and Pafuri areas,(two probable Slender and one probable Large Grey)	-

<b>Rock Dassie</b>	-	c.10 Daan Viljeon
<b>Hartmann's Mountain Zebra</b>	-	Eight Daan Viljeon Four Namib-Naukluft Very common Hobatere
<b>Burchell's Zebra</b>	Eight Croc Ranch Common Kruger	Abundant Etosha
<b>White Rhinoceros</b>	One N'watimhiri near Skukuza, Kruger, at 20 yards range while I was out of the car at a comfort stop Seven together at a wallow south of Skukuza	-
<b>Warthog</b>	Two Croc Ranch Kruger, seen on 8 days, a total of 21	Four Kirkveld – Otjiwarongo A surprisingly low total of four in Etosha Two Hobatere One south of Otjiwarongo
<b>Hippopotamus</b>	Seen on four dates in Kruger, a total of 28	-
<b>Giraffe</b>	16 Croc Ranch Seen on 8 out of 9 days in Kruger, max 20+ per day	Common Etosha Three Hobatere
<b>Cape Buffalo</b>	Kruger: singles SE of Shingwedzi and E of Satara	-
<b>Eland</b>	One Croc Ranch One Kruger (Timbavati)	-
<b>Kudu</b>	10 Croc Ranch Kruger, a total of 43 spread over 6 days	Etosha: 10 near Kaulheuwel Eight Hobatere
<b>Nyala</b>	c.10 Nyala Drive and Pafuri, Kruger	-
<b>Bushbuck</b>	Three Letaba, Kruger One Timbavati, Kruger	-

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<b>Sable</b>	One Croc Ranch One Pretoriuskup, Kruger	-
<b>Gemsbok</b>	-	Common Daan Viljeon, Namib-Naukluft, Etosha & Hobatere, surprisingly unapproachable
<b>Waterbuck</b>	Six Croc Ranch Small numbers, up to 20, on 7 days in Kruger	-
<b>Blue Wildebeest</b>	One Croc Ranch Kruger, up to c.25 on 7 days	Small numbers Daan Viljeon Common Etosha
<b>Red Hartebeest</b>	-	Etosha, a total of 21 including one group of 15 including calves, on 4 days, all near Halali
<b>Impala</b>	Common Croc Ranch & throughout Kruger	-
<b>'Black-faced' Impala</b>	-	Common in Etosha from Halali eastwards although small numbers further west near Olifantsbad
<b>Springbok</b>	-	Common Daan Viljeon, Namib-Naukluft, Etosha & Hobatere Four Uis – Omaruru
<b>Damara Dik-dik</b>	-	8+ Bloubokdraai, Etosha
<b>Klipspringer</b>	Two SW of Skukuza, Kruger	-
<b>Steenbok</b>	Three Croc Ranch Up to 5 daily in Kruger	Up to eight daily in Etosha Small numbers Hobatere
<b>Common Duiker</b>	-	One between Kamanjab and Outjo
<b>Cape Fur Seal</b>	-	Two Walvis Bay 100s Cape Cross
