Bobcat	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Anahuac NWR, two seen well for c.30 minutes early morning (one videoed) & another seen (and videoed) at close range at midday (27/12) ▪ One spotlighted along TX118 between Alpine & Study Butte (excellent views)

Mule Deer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Three Fort Davis Scenic Loop
White-tailed Deer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Four near Harper ▪ Three Green Gulch, Big Bend ▪ Two Chisos Basin, Big Bend ▪ Two Double Lake Recreation Area ▪ 100+ dead along Interstate 10 !
