### ITINERARY

28 <sup>th</sup>	Arrive Sao Paulo, flight to Campo Grande, drive to Passo do Lontra
29 <sup>th</sup>	Passo do Lontra area
30 <sup>th</sup>	Passo do Lontra area
31 <sup>st</sup>	Passo do Lontra area
1 <sup>st</sup>	Morning Passo do Lontra, afternoon drive to Campo Grande, flight to Sao Paulo
2 <sup>nd</sup>	Morning Nazareth Paulista, afternoon drive to Intervalles
3 <sup>rd</sup>	Intervalles all day
4 <sup>th</sup>	Morning Intervalles, afternoon return to Sao Paulo
5 <sup>th</sup>	Sao Paulo – Belo Horizonte – Sao Roque de Minas
6 <sup>th</sup>	Pousada Barcelos & Parque Nacional da Serra da Canastra.
7 <sup>th</sup>	Pousada Barcelos & Rio Sao Francisco between Sao Roque and Casca D'Anta.
8 <sup>th</sup>	Pousada Barcelos - Santuario do Caraca.
9 <sup>th</sup>	Santuário do Caraca.
10 <sup>th</sup>	Early morning in Caraca. Caraca to Ipanema stopping at Sitio Graciema for Geoffroy's Marmoset on route.
11 <sup>th</sup>	Estacao Biologica de Caratinga.
12 <sup>th</sup>	Ipanema to Belo (Pampulha) Airport, flight to Cuiaba via Sao Paulo (Congonhas)
13 <sup>th</sup>	Morning drive from Cuiaba to Pixaim at km 66 on the Transpantaneira. Afternoon cruise on Rio Pixaim. Evening spotlighting north of Pixaim.
14 <sup>th</sup>	Morning boat trip on Rio Pixaim or walk on trail behind hotel followed by morning drive to Pousada Jaguar. Afternoon continue driving south on Transpantaneira to Porto Jofre. Evening spotlighting on Transpantaneira.
15 <sup>th</sup>	Morning walk and drive on Transpantaneira. Midday and late afternoon boat rides on Rio Piquiri. Evening spotlighting on Transpantaneira.
16 <sup>th</sup>	Early morning walk near hotel. Morning boat ride on Rio Cuiaba and Rio Piquiri. Afternoon drive to Pousada Jaguar and evening spotlighting on Santa Isabel road and Transpantaneira.
17 <sup>th</sup>	Morning drive to Pousada Jaguar with short trail walk at start of Santa Isabel road. Afternoon walks and drives on trail opposite pousada and Santa Isabel road. Spotlighting north of Pousada Jaguar and along Santa Isabel road.
18 <sup>th</sup>	Pre-dawn spotlighting along Transpantaneira and Santa Isabel road. Early morning walks along Santa Isabel road and nearby trail. Morning drive to Pixaim. Afternoon boat trip on Rio Pixaim and walks on trail behind hotel. Pre and post dinner spotlighting along Transpantaneira.
19 <sup>th</sup>	Morning drive to Araras Ecologde and walk on tower hide trail. Afternoon return to Cuiaba for flight to Sao Paulo.
20 <sup>th</sup>	Morning flight to Manaus, afternoon gardens of Hotel Tropical
21 <sup>st</sup>	Morning flight to Tefe, boat to Mamiraua
22 <sup>nd</sup>	Mamiraua all day
23 <sup>rd</sup>	Mamiraua all day
24 <sup>th</sup>	Mamiraua all day
25 <sup>th</sup>	Morning boat to Tefe, flight to Manaus, afternoon grounds of Hotel Tropical
26 <sup>th</sup>	Morning grounds of Hotel Tropical, afternoon return flight to Sao Paulo & UK

Nine-banded Armadillo <i>Dasypus novemcinctus</i>	One Santa Isabel Road
Giant Anteater <i>Myrmecophaga tridactyla</i>	Two Serra da Canastra, one Transpantaneira N of Pixaim
Southern Tamandua <i>Tamandua tetradactyla</i>	Several dead on road between Campo Grande & Passo do Lontra
Brown-throated Sloth <i>Bradypus variegatus</i>	Singles Nazareth Paulista and Mamiraua
Guianan Squirrel <i>Sciurus aestuans</i>	5+ daily at Santuario do Caraca
Black Agouti <i>Dasyprocta</i>	One Santa Isabel Road
Azara's Agouti <i>Dasyprocta azarae</i>	3+ Santa Isabel Road
Brazilian Oryz <i>Dasyprocta</i>	One near Passo do Lontra
Capybara <i>Hydrochaeris hydrochaeris</i>	10+ daily Passo do Lontra, common along Transpantaneira
Jaguar <i>Panthera onca</i>	A total of four seen crippling well along the Rio Piquiri near Porto Jofre, a pregnant female with a full grown male cub from a previous litter, a massive adult male, and another adult female, the latter hunting along the riverbank.
<del>Onella <i>Felis tigrina</i></del>	Three two adults and a kitten, black morph, 4 kms from the entrance gate at Intervalles
Ocelot/Margay <i>Felis pardina/wiedii</i>	One Passo do Lontra
Maned Wolf <i>Chrysocyon brachyurus</i>	One Serra da Canastra, 2-3 Santuario do Caraca
Crab-eating Fox <i>Cerdocyon thous</i>	Two Passo do Lontra, five Intervalles, five along the Transpantaneira N of Pixaim and one along Santa Isabel Road
Neotropical River Otter <i>Lutra longicaudis</i>	Singles Passo do Lontra and Rio Pixaim
Giant Otter <i>Pteronura brasiliensis</i>	Two singles and two groups of three Passo do Lontra, 9+ Pixaim, three Rio Cuiaba, three Araras Ecologde
South American Coati <i>Nasua nasua</i>	One N of Pixaim, two Santa Isabel Road, 4+ Pixaim, groups of two and three between Pixaim & Araras Ecologde
Crab-eating Raccoon <i>Procyon cancrivorus</i>	Eight along the Transpantaneira N of Pixaim
Proboscis Bat <i>Myzomystus neso</i>	5+ Mamiraua
Lesser Fishing (Bulldog) Bat <i>Noctilio albigentris</i>	100s Passo do Lontra & Porto Jofre, smaller numbers Rio Pixaim
Greater Fishing (Bulldog) Bat <i>Noctilio leporinus</i>	100s Passo do Lontra & Porto Jofre, smaller numbers Rio Pixaim
Geoffroy's Marmoset <i>Callithrix geoffroyi</i>	12+ Sitio Graciema
Pied Bare-faced Tamarin <i>Saguinus bicolor</i>	3+ Hotel Tropical, Manaus
Black-striped Capuchin <i>Cebus apella</i>	Seen along the Transpantaneira on 6 days, at least 45 individuals seen, small numbers on 2 days at Mamiraua
Black Capuchin <i>Cebus nigritus</i>	20+ Caratinga
Masked Tit (Monkey) <i>Callitrix personatus</i>	Four Nazareth Paulista
Red (White) Uakari <i>Cacajao calvus</i>	1-3 seen on three days at Mamiraua
Common Squirrel Monkey <i>Saimiri sciureus</i>	Up to 10 seen daily at Mamiraua
Black Squirrel Monkey <i>Saimiri yambolini</i>	1-5 on 3 days at Mamiraua
Northern Muriqui <i>Brachyteles hypoxanthus</i>	c.30 Caratinga
Southern Muriqui <i>Brachyteles arachnoides</i>	5+ on two days at Intervalles
Black (and Gold) Howler Monkey <i>Alouatta caraya</i>	Three groups of six and two single males Passo do Lontra, a total of 30+ seen over 4 days along the Transpantaneira
Brown Howler Monkey <i>Alouatta guariba</i>	20+ Caratinga
Red Howler <i>Alouatta seniculus</i>	Up to 20 daily at Mamiraua
Collared Peccary <i>Dicotyles tajacu</i>	8+ Transpantaneira N of Araras Ecologde
White-lipped Peccary <i>Tayassu pecari</i>	30+ near Passo do Lontra, two (plus others heard) along Transpantaneira S of Pixaim, one Araras Ecologde
Pampas Deer <i>Ozotoceros bezoarticus</i>	Two Serra da Canastra
Red Brocket <i>Mazama americana</i>	Two near Passo do Lontra, a total of seven along the Transpantaneira
Gray Brocket <i>Mazama gouazoubira</i>	One Araras Ecologde
Marsh Deer <i>Blastocerus dichotomus</i>	Four near Passo do Lontra, a total of 23 along the Transpantaneira, possibly includes some duplication.
Brazilian Tapir <i>Tapirus terrestris</i>	One Rio Piquiri near Porto Jofre, one along Transpantaneira N of Pixaim
Pink River Dolphin <i>Inia geoffrensis</i>	Up to 10 a day around Tefe and Mamiraua
Grey River Dolphin <i>Sotalia fluviatilis</i>	Up to 5 on 2 days at Mamiraua
