Grey Four-eyed Opossum	One Cock-of-The-Rock Lodge, feeding on the bird table (& videoed)
Opossum sp	One with a third furred tail feeding on bananas in the kitchen at Cock-of-the-Rock Lodge,
Bat sp	Several species were seen especially at the tapir lick at Manu Wildlife Center but remain unidentified. Others unidentified bats roosted in the toilets at Cocha Salvador & under small palm leaves on the trail near CS campsite (videoed).
Brown Capuchin	Small numbers; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • along the Manu road below Cock of the Rock Lodge • Amazonia Lodge, • Cocha Salvador campsite (videoed) • Near Pakitza (videoed) • Manu Wildlife Center
White-faced Capuchin	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Three near Cocha Salvador campsite • Two groups at Manu Wildlife Center, a small group, <5, with other primates and a larger, >20, single species group (videoed)
Dusky-Titi Monkey	One near Cocha Otorongo (videoed)
Black Spider Monkey	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2+ on ridge near Amazonia Lodge • Small numbers near Cocha Salvador & near Pakitza (both videoed)
Common Woolly Monkey	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One near Cock-of -the-Rock Lodge. • Common Cocha Salvador (videoed)
Red Howler Monkey	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Five Cocha Salvador (videoed) • Three Manu Wildlife Center (videoed)
Squirrel Monkey	Common Amazonia Lodge including one large, pre-roost group of c.100. Small numbers Cocha Salvador (videoed) & Manu Wildlife Center
Saddleback Tamarin	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Four near Boca Manu Auberge • Five near Cocha Otorongo (videoed) • 10+ Manu Wildlife Center
Emperor Tamarin	One seen briefly near Boca Manu Auberge
Giant River Otter	Excellent views (videoed) of three, adult plus two cubs, along the Manu River near Cocha Otorongo, seen both in and out of water.
Sechura Fox	One Loma de Lachay National Park (videoed)

Red Brocket Deer	Two at tapir lick Manu Wildlife Center (videoed)
Brazilian Tapir	2-3 at tapir lick Manu Wildlife Center (videoed)
Collared Peccary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two near Cocha Salvador campsite • Two groups, at least 7 animals in total, Manu Wildlife Center
White-lipped Peccary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Three seen (videoed) near Pakitza (part of a large group) • Two near Cocha Salvador campsite (part of same group)
Capybara	One seen briefly along Madre de Dios River
Brown Agouti	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Seen well (videoed) Cock-of-the-Rock Lodge • Seen well Manu Wildlife Center • Others heard Cocha Salvador & Manu Wildlife Center
South Amazon Red Squirrel	<p>Small numbers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Amazonia Lodge (videoed) • Near Cocha Salvador campsite • Cocha Otorongo • Manu Wildlife Center
