ITINERARY

20 th	Late afternoon arrival in Kathmandu, transferred to Hotel Dynasty
21 st	Morning - Kathmandu – Chitwan. Afternoon. Chitwan, elephant ride in grasslands
22 nd	Chitwan, Gaida Lodge area including morning & afternoon elephant rides in forest & grasslands, and morning walk in woodland
23 rd	Morning transferred to Gaida Tented Camp, late morning and afternoon in adjacent woodland
24 th	Early morning walk in woodland, transferred back to Gaida Lodge, afternoon around lodge
25 th	Transferred to Koshi stopping at Koshi Barrage on route, afternoon Koshi Camp area
26 th	Koshi Camp area
27 th	Koshi Camp area
28 th	Transferred to Biratnagar for morning flight to Kathmandu. Late afternoon at Nagerjun
29 th	Early morning transfer to airport for return flight

Indian Flying Fox	<i>Pteropus giganteus</i>	Four Koshi Camp, 10+ Biratnagar
Rhesus Macaque	<i>Macaca mulatta</i>	Three Chitwan, two Kathmandu
Tarai Gray Langur	<i>Semnopithecus hector</i>	Seen at Chitwan on 2 days, 15+ animals
Asiatic Golden Jackal	<i>Canis lupis</i>	Seen daily at Koshi Camp, minimum of 6 animals including 3 young.
Bengal Fox	<i>Vulpes bengalensis</i>	One near Koshi
Indian Grey Mongoose	<i>Herpestes edwardsi</i>	One Chitwan, three Koshi Camp
Jungle Cat	<i>Felis chaus</i>	Singles Hotel Dynasty Kathmandu & Koshi Camp
Tiger	<i>Panthera tigris</i>	Two male & female at remains of feral buffalo kill in Chitwan
Gangetic River Dolphin	<i>Platanista gangetica</i>	Four Koshi Barrage
Indian Rhinoceros	<i>Rhinoceros unicornis</i>	Chitwan, seen on first two days, daily counts of four and eight including three calves
Wild Boar	<i>Sus scrofa</i>	Two groups of three in Chitwan
Indian Muntjac	<i>Muntiacus muntjak</i>	One Chitwan
Chital	<i>Cervus axis</i>	A minimum of eleven in Chitwan
Hog Deer	<i>Cervus porcinus</i>	Chitwan, daily counts of one, 4+ & 2, one Koshi Camp
Sambar	<i>Cervus unicolor</i>	Chitwan, daily counts of 4, 2 & one.
Wild Water Buffalo	<i>Bubalus bubalis</i>	Eleven Koshi Camp
Orange-bellied Squirrel	<i>Dremomys lokriah</i>	Five Nagerjun
Indian Hare	<i>Lepus nigricollis</i>	One Koshi Camp
Asian Elephant	<i>Elephas maximus</i>	Male Chitwan
