Chambi, Bou hedma and Jbil with Karim from Real golf travel

Some difficulties to visit Chambi because some armed group are hide in the mountain, we can only visit the 3 firsts kilometers of the main road of the park.

No problem in Bou Hedma, the park is now split in two different parks (Bou Hedma park and Gafsa Park). You can sleep in the park (Two houses). We saw 10 differents eyes of canid during the night but at each time it was too distant for identification.

We stay only one evening in Jbil national park, the park rangers have a Isuzu for the game night. You can sleep in the park (Two houses)

- 1- Fennec (Vulpes zerda) : 1 in the Jbil National park during the night drive
- 2- Golden jackal (Canis aureus) : 2 in Bou Hedma during day time
- 3- Red Fox (Vulpes vulpes) : 1 In the entrance of Bou Hedma during day time

Rüppell's fox (*Vulpes rueppellii*) : Not totaly sure !! 5km before the entrance of Jbil National park

4- Dorcas gazelle (Gazella dorcas) : 3 groups in Bou Hedma

- 5- Addax (Addax nasomaculatus) : 2 groups in Bou Hedma
- 6- Scimitar-horned oryx (Oryx dammah): 2 groups in Bou Hedma
- 7- Barbary Sheep (Ammotragus lervia): 5
- 8- Lesser Egyptian jerboa (Jaculus jaculus): 1 in Jbil National park during night drive
- 9- Common Gundi (Ctenodactylus gundi) : 3 in Bou Hedma
- 10- Lesser Gerbil (Gerbillus gerbillus) : ++ cross the road between Jbil and Douz during night time

11- **Cape Hare** (Lepus capensis) : 1 in Bou Hedma and 2 in the road between Jbil and Douz during night time
