Bat sp		Several around Embalse Encinerajo
Iberian Hare	<i>Lepus granatensis</i>	One while spotlighting between Los Escoriales & La Lanche on 4 May
European Rabbit	<i>Oryctolagus cuniculus</i>	Several seen in the area west of Embalse Encinerajo & while spotlighting near Los Escoriales
Wood Mouse	<i>Apodemus sylvaticus</i>	Several between Los Escoriales & La Lanche while spotlighting on 4 May
Otter	<i>Lutra lutra</i>	Two along the Rio Jandula west of Embalse Encinerajo on the evening of 4 May
Iberian Lynx	<i>Lynx pardinus</i>	One seen well, albeit briefly, from the main watchpoint c.1 km SW of Embalse Encinerajo about an hour after first light on 4 May. Seen at c.150m range for 30 seconds before disappearing into riverside vegetation.
Wild Boar	<i>Sus scrofa</i>	3 May – a group of 4 from the watchpoint along the Rio Jandula. 4 May - a single adult plus 2 adults with 9 young from the watchpoint along the Rio Jandula.
Mouflon	<i>Ovis musimon</i>	3 May – a single plus a group of 5 while spotlighting SW of Los Escoriales 4 May – a single while spotlighting SW of Los Escoriales 5 May – 7+ a km N of Los Escoriales on the road to La Lanche mid-morning
Red Deer	<i>Cervus elaphus</i>	Very common from the watchpoint along the Rio Jandula & SW of Los Escoriales
Fallow Deer	<i>Cervus dama</i>	Two near Embalse Encinerajo, 10+ from the viewpoint along the Rio Jandula & small numbers SW of Los Escoriales
