# **Coke Smith - Mammal Trip**

### The Atlantic Rainforest and the Amazon Rainforest

# 25 June to 20 July

### **Pantanal & Emas National Park**

### 01 to 12 August

- Day 1, Sun (25 Jun) Arrival in São Paulo (09:40h Qatar Air QR779). Transfer to Nazareth Paulista, 70km from airport. Afternoon, first try for Buffy-tufted Marmoset and Black-fronted Titi Monkey. Overnight.(L/D)
- Day 2, Mon (26 Jun) Nazareth Paulista in the morning looking for monkeys and Brownthroated Three-toed sloth. After lunch drive to Carlos Botelho State Park, 282 km or approximately 4hs away. Overnight.(B/L/D)
- **Day 3, Tue (27 Jun) –** Morning hiking into the park with Monkey Safari team to try the Southern Muriqui. Then drive to Buri, 105 km or 2 hs to be there early afternoon to have the first try for Black-lion-tamarin. Evening night drive with chances for Crab-eating fox, Hoary fox, Southern Tamandua and others. Overnight. **.(B/L/D)**
- Day 4, Wed (28 Jun) All morning at Buri looking for Black Lion Tamarin. Afternoon drive back to São Paulo. Fly to Rio de Janeiro (LA 20h45/21h45). Overnight. .(B/L/D)
- Day 5, Thu (29 Jun) Early drive go North towards Unamar, 172km where it occurs a population of Golden Lion Tamarin. Spend all day in the area. Overnight. .(B/L/D)
- Day 6, Fri (30 Jun) Morning in the park. Then drive back to Rio de Janeiro. Fly to Vitoria (LA 14h25/15h30). Transfer to Linhares, Vale Natural Reserve for 168km or about 3hs. Overnight. .(B/L/D)
- **Day 7, Sat (01 Jul) –** Linhares, Vale Natural Reserve. Spend all day. Species to try here are Masked Titi Monkey, Geoffroy's Marmoset, Robust Capuchin, Red-rumped Agouti. Overnight. **.(B/L/D)**
- **Day 8, Sun (02 Jul) –** Linhares in the morning. Early afternoon drive to Santa. Teresa, 108km or 2hs. Possible visit the Park of the Museum Prof. Mello Leitão where is possible to see Masked Titi Monkey and Black -tufted Marmoset. Overnight. **.(B/L/D)**
- **Day 9, Mon (03 Jul) –** Early drive to Afonso Claudio, 87km or 2hs. Visit private properties in the area to try Masked Titi Monkey, Brown Hower, Buffy-headed Marmoset, Bahia Hairy-dwarf Porcupine, Brazilian Cavy, Black-eared Opossum, Maned Sloth, Brown-throated-three-toed Sloth. Overnight. **.(B/L/D)**
- Day 10, Tue (04 Jul) Afonso Claudio all day. Overnight. .(B/L/D)
- Day 11, Wed (05 Jul) Early drive to Caratinga. Afternoon visit the reserve. Overnight. .(B/L/D)
- **Day 12, Thu (06 Jul) –** Caratinga all day looking for Northern Muriqui, Black Capuchin, Brown Howler and Buffy-headed Marmoset. Overnight. **.(B/L/D)**

Day 13, Fri (07 Jul) – Transfer to Rio Doce State Park, 120km or about 3hs. Here the targets would Black-fronted Titi Monkey. Other species such as Black Capuchin, Geoffroy's Marmoset also occurs. Overnight. .(B/L/D)

**Day 14, Sat (08 Jul) –** Rio Doce State Park in the morning. Then, drive to Caraça Seminary and Natural Reserve for 183km (around 4hs). This evening will be your first try to see the Maned Wolf. Overnight. **.(B/L/D)** 

**Day 15, Sun (09 Jul) –** Caraça all day. Walking in the surroundings to look for Masked Titi Monkey, Brazilian Squirrel, Gray-brocket deer. Evening try the Maned Wolf. Overnight. **.(B/L/D)** 

Day 16, Mon (10 Jul) – Early drive to Belo Horizonte airport, 145km (3hs). Fly to Ilheus (AD 10h20/11h45). Overnight. .(B/L/D)

**Day 17, Tue (11 Jul) –** Iheus region. Here your targets would be Weid's Marmoset, Goldenheaded Lion Tamarin, Yellow breasted Capuchin, Coastal-black-handed Titi Monkey, Maned sloth. Overnight. **.(B/L/D)** 

Day 18, Wed (12 Jul) - Ilheus region. Overnight. .(B/L/D)

Day 19, Thu (13 Jul) – Ilheus region most of the day. Fly to Salvador (G-3 18h30/19h25). Overnight. .(B/L/D)

**Day 20, Fri (14 Jul)** – Early drive to Estancia, 255km or about 4hs. There you would be looking for Coimbra Filho's Titi Monkey. Overnight. **.(B/L/D)** 

**Day 21, Sat (15 Jul) –** Another day in Estancia. Drive to Aracaju, 60km (1 and a half). Fly to Manaus (**AD 19h00/ 01h00+**). Overnight. **.(B/L)** 

Day 22, Sun (16 Jul) - Day Dayse. Overnight. .(B)

Day 23, Mon (17 Jul) - Day Dayse. Overnight. .(B)

Day 24, Tue (18 Jul) – Morning in search for primates and other mammals. Afternoon boat ride along the Rio Negro in search for Tucuxi Dolphin and Pink River Dolphin. Overnight. .(B)

Day 25, Wed (19 Jul) - Manaus all day in search for primates and other mammals. Overnight.

**Day 26, Thu (20 Jul) – MUSA** Tower at sunrise to try Guianan Red-Howler and Guianan-brown-bearded Saki. **.(B)** 

Fly from Manaus to Quito (LA15h55 / 12h25+) or to Santiago (LA 15h55/20h50 w/ connection in SP, departing 23h10 /02h35).

Days, 27 to 37, Fri to Mon (Jul 21 to 31) - Arica - Buenos Aires - Quito

Day 38, Tue (1 Aug) - Arrival in Brazil. Fly to Campo Grande . .(L/D)

Flight from Buenos Aires to Campo Grande (LA Departure 02h30 Arrival 08h20).

Meet the guide in Campo Grande airport and drive to Aguape Lodge. 193km or approximately 3hs. This property in the Southern Pantanal is the base of the Giant Anteater project. Very good chances to find this species as well as Southern Tamandua, Pampa's deer, Yellow Armadillo, Coatimundi, Azara's Capuchin, Collared Peccary and others.

**Day 39, Wed (02 Aug) –** Aguape Lodge in the morning. Lunch. Drive to Campo Grande. Overnight. **.(B/L/D)** 

Day 40, Thu (03 Aug) - Breakfast and drive to Emas. 338km or about 5hs. .(B/L/D)

Overnight in Chapada do Ceu city (49 km from Emas National Park).

Species possible to see here includes, Brazilian Tapir, Crab-eating fox, Hoary Fox, Pampas cat, Maned Wolf, Hog-nosed Skunk, White-lipped peccary, Pampas deer, Giant anteater, Yellow armadillo.

Day 41, Fri (04 Aug) – Emas all day. Overnight in Chapada do Ceu city (49 km from Emas National Park). .(B/L/D)

Day 42, Sat (05 Aug) – Emas all day. Overnight in Chapada do Ceu city (49 km from Emas National Park). .(B/L/D)

Day 43, Sun (06 Aug) – Emas all day. Overnight in Chapada do Ceu city (49 km from Emas National Park). .(B/L/D)

**Day 44, Mon (07 Aug) –** Emas in the morning. Transfer to Campo Grande, 338km or about 5hs. Overnigth. **.(B/L/D)** 

Day 45, Tue (08 Aug) – Early flight to Cuiaba (AD 03h00 / 04h10). This is the only one available at the moment). Breakfast in the Route. Transfer from Cuiaba to Jofre arriving for lunch.( 252km or about 5-6hs)

Afternoon boat ride. Overnight.Berço Pantaneiro Lodge .(B/L/D

**Day 46, Wed (09 Aug)** – Porto Jofre region by boat in search for jaguar and other wildlife. Overnight.Berço Pantaneiro Lodge .(B/L/D).

**Day 47, Thu (10 Aug) –** Morning Porto Jofre region by boat in search for jaguar and other wildlife. Lunch and Transfer to Pouso Alegre. Here is possible to see Brazilian Tapir, Redbrocket deer, Gray brocket deer, Azara´s Capuchin, Black-tailed marmoset, Azara´s Agouti and others. Overnight. **.(B/L/D)** 

Day 48, Fri (11 Aug) – Morning Pouso Alegre.. Lunch. Afternoon transfer to Cuiaba.(133km or about 3hs). Fly to São Paulo (AD 20h20 / 23h30). Overnight. .(B/L/D)

Day 49, Sat (12 Aug) – Visit São Paulo Botanical Garden in the morning. Fly home (20:35 Qatar Air QR 780) .(B)
